

## Helpful Tips for Booking Online

Because of our unique lodging situation, we understand that it can be a little difficult to book your trip online. Below are some tips that we hope will make your online booking experience easier.

**PLEASE NOTE: Our reservation system is designed to work with Internet Explorer. If you are using a different browser, you may experience glitches and/or inconsistencies when booking. (Google Chrome and Safari users seem to have the most trouble).**

1. Each of our three Huts has two types of lodging accommodations, Private Bunkrooms and Shared Bunkspace.

**Private Bunkrooms** are booked at a flat rate per night instead of a per person rate to guarantee that they remain private regardless of if they are full or not. At our

Poplar Hut: Two Private Bunkrooms, each with a double bed and two single bunks to comfortably sleep a maximum of 4 people.

Flagstaff Hut: Four Private Bunkrooms, each with a double bed and a single bunk to comfortably sleep a maximum of 3 people.

Grand Falls Hut: Two Private Bunkrooms, each with just one double bed to comfortably sleep a maximum of 2 people.

**Shared Bunkspace** is booked per person per night and bunks are assigned by the Hut Staff upon arrival at the Hut. Privacy cannot be guaranteed.

Poplar Hut: Sleeps 36 people in Shared Bunkspace.

Flagstaff Hut: Sleeps 36 people in Shared Bunkspace.

Grand Falls Hut: Sleeps 28 people in Shared Bunkspace.

2. Because of the way our lodging is set up, you should *always* search for 1 adult. **Doing this will return ALL available lodging results.** If you searched for 2 or more people and received an error, go back and try searching for 1 adult and 0 children. (You will be able to select the number of adults/children and members/non-members after you search availability.)

3. If you wish to book a Hut-to-Hut trip, begin by searching only for the date(s) you wish to spend at your first hut. For example, if you wish to stay at Poplar on 1/27/12 and Flagstaff on 1/28/12, put 1/27 as your "arrive" and 1/28 as your "depart" then select your lodging at Poplar.


4. Once lodging results appear, you will see a page similar to this, based on where lodging is available:

6. When booking Shared Bunkspace, click **“Want more than one?”** to add multiple people (beds) at once and select the number of people for which that rate applies, then click **“Select.”** (If booking *Private Bunkrooms*, clicking *“Want more than one?”* will let you select additional *Private Bunkrooms*)

9. When the window pops up, enter only the date(s) you intend to stay at your second hut, i.e. Check In: 1/28/12 and Check Out: 1/29/12. Remember to make sure you are searching for 1 Adult and 0 Children!

10. When booking gear transport, be sure to select transport on the correct date and in the right direction based on your stay. (i.e. If you are staying at Poplar on 1/27 then at Flagstaff on 1/28 you will want to select “PSH to FLH” on 1/28/2012)

The following key will help you with the transport abbreviations:

- PSH: Poplar Stream Falls Hut
- FLH: Flagstaff Lake Hut
- GFH: Grand Falls Hut
- LFD: Long Falls Dam Rd. Trailhead
